I hope you all had an enjoyable Christmas holiday break with your tamariki and we are all ready to go for 2024. It has been lovely to see everyone back at school.

Our new school timetable - Wātaka hou

We have made a few changes to the structure of our school day to maximise learning time and provide opportunity for students to emotionally regulate throughout the day.

9.00am - 9.15: Administration

9.15am - 10.05am - Learning Block 1

10.05am - 10.15am: Brain break - Snack

10.15am - 11.05am: Learning Block 2

11.05am - 11.15am: Supervised eating

11.15 - 11.35: Independent Mobility - Schoolwide

11.35am -12.25pm: Learning Block 3

12.25pm - 1.15pm: Learning Block 4

1.15pm - 1.25pm: Supervised eating & Roll

1.25pm - 1.55pm: Independent Mobility - Schoolwide

1.55m - 2.45pm: Learning Block 5

2.45pm - 3.00pm: End of day reflections, Set up for next day, Pack up.

Please note - there may be some slight variation to this depending on year levels where teachers will monitor the needs of their class and adjust accordingly.

Other additions to our daily timetable will be regular learning blocks with Mrs Mac - PE & Health, Mr Kidd - Performing Arts & Music and Mr Yosuke Hase - Environmental Learning.

Swimming - Kauhoe

Swimming is also back into our learning blocks so please keep an eye on the SeeSaw notices from your child's teacher so you know when to pack those togs and a towel. Goggles will also help but are not compulsory. We will need at least 1 parent help on the days that our Junior classes are swimming so if you are free - please let our teachers know.
