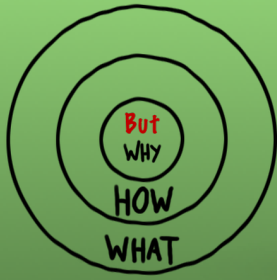
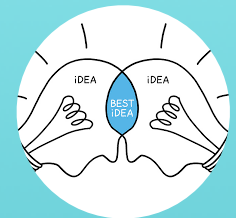

Two or more teachers working effectively together helps improve the quality of teaching and learning in a number of ways. Teachers working collaboratively...

- Share the responsibility for the class of students
- Build on each others strengths and skills
- Engage in reflection about teaching and learning more deeply and frequently
- Provide more differentiation to support all learners
- Have access to a wider range of strengths and passions to support learners
- Provide greater opportunity for students to form a strong connection with at least one teacher
- Provide a greater variety of teaching methods for supporting students

Why Collaborative Teaching?

It is the power that comes from collective teacher efficacy. This collective belief of teachers in their ability to positively impact on student outcomes is known as the most influential factor on student achievement. Collective teacher efficacy in fact has substantially more impact on positively influencing student outcomes when compared to student motivation, concentration, and engagement, socio-economic status, homework, or prior achievement. Collaborative teaching enables greater collective teacher efficacy.
