# FROM THE PRINCIPAL

***Kia ora koutou,***

I hope you have all had a fantastic week. Our tamariki are getting into their new daily routines with the change up in our school timetable. Feedback so far is that the shorter last block of one hour means children are more focussed and teachers can get some quality learning time in spite of the hot afternoons. I hope some of you are managing to enjoy our rivers and lakes while we can.

## **Swimming - Kauhoe**

It is fantastic that we have this resource available to us. Every class has the opportunity to swim each week. I want to say a huge thank you to one of our parents - Duncan Ashford for his expert guidance, leading and monitoring of the pool refurbishment last year. We certainly can't thank you enough Duncan. Also a big shout out to you - our community for supporting the fundraising efforts throughout 2023. Without your support, we could not have done this. On that note: I haven't forgotten about inviting our last year's Year 6's for a pool night. I promise to look into this.

We have one more task on hand and that is heating the pool to allow us to use it effectively in Terms 2 & 3. We hope to get this sorted soon. In the meantime, we are grateful for the warm weather which means the cool of the water is welcomed.

Please note: At this stage we are not inviting any swim schools in to use the pool at this time. This is so we can identify exactly what it takes to keep our water quality at a consistent premium and what costs are involved in running our pool. This may be something we will look at for term 2 and beyond.

## **Water Safety - Kia Maanu, Kia Ora**

We have very high expectations and strict procedures in place to ensure the safety of our tamariki is paramount when using our pool. We know it is exciting to be in and around the pool however children may be asked to sit on the bleachers and watch if children are not in the correct swimming attire or their behaviour on the day may challenge our expectations.

## **Sunsmart - Rā atamai**

It's pretty hot out there and we need to do what we can to keep our tamariki safe. Please sunblock your child before they leave for school and start the day by wearing a hat. We will have sunblock in classes and we will also be reminding them to wear a hat when leaving the classroom.

Please contact your child's teacher if you need some extra time or if we can assist you in any way.

***Heads up*** - Apologies, the short week has got us. Consultation with you will start next week in regards to a slight change to our start and finish time. ## LYNMORE NETBALL - TERM 1 2024

The Term 1 Future Ferns programme is a 6 week programme for Years 0-6.

**New players are welcome at all grades!** The programme offers a modified version of netball starting with small teams and courts for Years 0-2 and progressing to full sized courts and larger teams for Years 5-6.

### **COST:**

Year 1/2 \$30 Year 3/4 \$30

Year 5/6 \$35

**DAY:** Games are played on Monday afternoons. Games begin on Monday, 26th February.

**TIME:** Year 1-4 play at 4.00pm, Year 5/6 play at 5.00pm. Practice times are determined by the team coach.

**VENUE:** All games are played at the Rotorua Netball Courts on Malfroy Road. Practices will be held at Lynmore School.

**COACHES:** Each team requires a coach. Teams cannot be entered into the competition without parent help. During the game, our Year 1/2 and 3/4 coaches are on court with their teams supporting and encouraging

our players. Additional parent support is required for sideline management and substitutions. An umpire will be supplied for our Year 5/6 teams so coaches will not be required to umpire at this level. Please indicate on the form if you are able to assist with coaching a team.
