## ***Tena koutou katoa,***

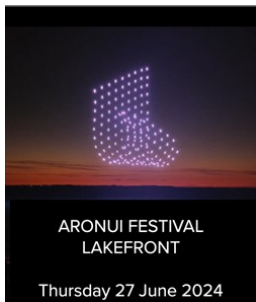
