# FROM THE PRINCIPAL ...

## ***Kia ora koutou***

Welcome back to school. I hope you all had a lovely term 3 school holiday time with your tamariki and we look forward to providing exciting learning experiences for your child. I would like to welcome our new students who started on Monday. It has been lovely watching them move around the school to help get them used to where everything is and what our in-school routines look like.

**Welcome** to our new teacher Matua Nikau who has joined Whaea Shaminder in Ihenga 0.

It has also been amazing to see more of our tamariki walking or biking to school. This is fantastic! This also means we need all of our parents to be extra careful when driving or parking cars around the school.

## **Curriculum Teacher-Only day - Friday 15th November**

The last of the MOE approved teacher only days for 2024 needs to be taken between the 21st October and 15th November. Please see a snippet of the MOE notification:

Curriculum teacher-only days

In November, there is one more previously approved teacher-only day (TOD) that meets these criteria. The delivery of this TOD has been made more flexible so schools and kura can use this day to cover one of the required three days of structured literacy approaches or Rangaranga Reo ā-Tā. Teachers and kaiako not involved in this professional learning and development (PLD) could use the time to cover the material focused on maths and pāngarau curriculum implementation.

Our choice is to have this on Friday November 15th. The focus of our Teacher Only day will be based on the new Mathematics Curriculum and the MOE funded resources (announced yesterday). We have two of our local MOE Curriculum Leads coming to work with us on this day. Changes are happening at pace and we are committed to ensuring we are making the right choices for our school community.

## **New Shade Sails & Hats on for Term 4**

These were put up during the school holidays and I think they look fantastic. Come in and take a look if you get a chance. I have really enjoyed seeing our kids bring their learning space outside the classroom and also seeing our Year 2 children in the Play Based Learning environments under the sails.
