Kia ora e te whānau,

At our hui on Tuesday night we reflected on what a full and exciting year 2024 was. We want to take this opportunity to celebrate the success of all our tamariki. Every ākonga/student has grown and developed at their own rate and our end of year achievement data shows that our staff are doing everything they can to support the tamariki in their akomanga/classroom to be their best. Any learning challenges are identified so if your tamaiti/child is moving to a new teacher next year, be assured that their strengths, unique needs and progress are handed over so they can hit the ground running in 2025. For this update we thought we'd share the highlights of what was a busy year!

Property & Finance

- Perimeter Fence: Our new fence might have taken a lot longer than expected, but now it's in, we're enjoying the safety it provides. Gates are never locked so the community will always be welcome outside of school hours.
- Shade Sails: These went up in time to protect our tamariki from the summer sun. They are bright, colourful and make our school grounds pop. Thank you to our Tumuaki/Principal Hinei and Kerrie for all their mahi behind the scenes seeking the funding for these.
- Aging Prefab Classrooms: These classrooms are a top priority for remediation. We have identified the need for their replacement with the Ministry of Education. We will continue to make creative use of outdoor spaces, including the new shade sails.
- Gym Restoration & Admin Block: Plans for the gym and admin block improvements have been approved and will hopefully start soon. Both are weather related improvements. The temporary loss of our gym will create disruption for our community, but the result will be an improved space that will last for many more years.

A massive thank you to our caregiver and grounds team **Heke** and **Tony** for all their mahi this year. Our grounds look fantastic! We also appreciate all the creative cost effective solutions and little fixes. We are lucky to have you on the team.

Health & Safety

- Before and After School: Please remember that staff are not available
 to watch your children outside the hours of 8.30 and 3.15. If your child is







